GO Media Mix

description

A composted mulch with a predominantly 8 to 15mm size range. This product retains a small percentage of fine compost and is therefore useful for planting directly into without the need for soil conditioning. GO Media Mulch is more consistent in size than GO Mulch which makes it more reliable for mechanical spreading.

source

Composted mulch manufactured from recycled organics according to procedures outlined in AS4454 - Mulch.
